1. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES – January 14, 2010**

MOTION BY LOPEZ, seconded by Moeller, to approve the minutes of the January 14, 2010, meeting as circulated. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

2. **DISCLOSURES**

John Spiegelberg had a conversation with a County Commissioner regarding Agenda Item #6 but did not feel he had a conflict of interest.

3. **REQUEST FOR STOP CONTROL/4-WAY STOP – FILLMORE & MONROE STREETS**

Robert N. Trout, 1678 Monroe Street, and Connie Wibbens, 236 Fillmore Street, requested stop control/4-way stop at the intersection of Fillmore and Monroe Streets.

MOTION BY MOELLER, seconded by Lopez, to deny the request for placement of stop signs at the intersection of Fillmore and Monroe Streets. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

4. **REQUEST FOR STOP CONTROL – 13TH & ARNOLD/SYMONS STREETS**

Karen Valentine-Pond, representing the Fall Creek Homeowners Association, requested placement of stop signs at the intersection of 13th and Arnold Streets and 13th and Symons Streets.

Staff received an email on March 10, 2010, requesting the item be postponed until the April 8, 2010, meeting due to a scheduling conflict.

MOTION BY SINDELAR, seconded by Moeller, to postpone the request for stop control at 13th and Arnold/Symons Streets to the April 8, 2010, meeting. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

5. **REQUEST FOR GENERAL RESERVED HANDICAPPED SPACE – 1415 FLINT STREET**

Millard Paustian, 1415 Flint Street, requested placement of a general reserved handicapped space adjacent to his residence.

MOTION BY MOELLER, seconded by Sindelar, to approve placement of a general reserved handicapped space adjacent to 1415 Flint Street. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.**

6. **DISCUSSION OF HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES ACCESSIBILITY/DOWNTOWN LARAMIE AREA**

Discussion of handicapped parking and accessibility focused on the public parking lot at 1st Street and Grand Avenue and On-Street Handicapped Parking in the Laramie Downtown Area. Kendall Corbett and Christine Clements, Laramie Advisory Commission on Disabilities (LACD) members, brought forward concerns regarding parking lot striping and accessibility of the intersection at 30th Street and Grand Avenue.

Due to construction of the 1st Street Plaza, the handicapped spaces for the public parking lot at 1st Street and Grand Avenue have been removed. It is the intent to restripe the remaining spaces to provide handicapped parking, including spaces which are van accessible. City Staff will provide a copy of the striping plan to the LACD for the Committee's review.

Randy Griesbach, WYDOT, informed the Commission that reconstruction of the intersection at 30th Street and Grand Avenue has been set for WYDOT Fiscal Year 2013.
