



Plumbing Permit Fee Schedule

Effective: January 1, 2003

| 1. For each plumbing fixture on one trap (including water, drainage piping and backflow protection therefor) | \$ 7.00 |
| 2. Each water or sewer service line installation or replacement | \$15.00 |
| 3. Rainwater systems – per drain (inside building) | \$ 7.00 |
| 4. Each new or enlarged water or sewer tap | \$20.00 |
| 5. Each private sewage disposal system | \$40.00 |
| 6. Each water heater and/or vent | \$ 7.00 |
| 7. Each gas-piping system (1-5 outlets) | \$ 5.00 |
| 8. For each additional gas piping system outlet, per outlet | \$ 1.00 |
| 9. For each industrial waste pretreatment interceptor including its trap and vent, except kitchen-type grease interceptors functioning as fixture traps | \$ 7.00 |
| 10. For each installation, alteration or repair of water piping and/or water treating equipment, each | \$ 7.00 |
| 11. For each repair or alteration of drainage or vent piping, each fixture | \$ 7.00 |
| 12. For each lawn sprinkler system on any one meter including backflow protection devices therefor | \$ 7.00 |

| 16. For initial installation and testing for a reclaimed water system | \$30.00* |
| 17. For each annual cross-contamination testing of a reclaimed water system (excluding initial test) | \$30.00* |
| 18. For each medical gas piping system serving 1-5 inlet(s)/outlet(s) for a specific gas | \$50.00 |
| 19. For each additional medical gas inlet(s)/outlet(s) | \$ 5.00 |
| 20. For each fire protection system – Table 1-A, Uniform Building Code. | |
| 21. For each petroleum products system – Table 1-A, Uniform Building Code. | |
| 22. Each boiler to and including 100,000 Btu/h | \$14.70 |
| 23. Each boiler 100,001 to 500,000 Btu/h | \$27.15 |

| 25. Each boiler 1,000,001 to 1,750,000 Btu/h | \$55.45 |

| Other Inspections and Fees | Fees |
| 1. Inspections outside of normal business hours | \$30.00* |
| 2. Reinspection fee | \$30.00 |
| 3. Inspections for which no fee is specifically indicated | \$30.00* |
| 4. Plan Review Fee – 65% of the total permit fee. | |
| 5. Additional plan review due to changes or incomplete plans (minimum charge – ½ hour) | \$30.00* |
| 6. Investigation fee: work started without a permit – fee equal to the amount of, in addition to, the required plumbing permit fee. | |
| 7. Work in buildings/facilities owned and operated solely by the University of Wyoming or State of Wyoming with a valuation of less than \$5,000.00 is exempt from the permit fees established herein provided that permits are obtained for such work. | |

*Or the total hourly cost to the jurisdiction, whichever is the greatest. This cost shall include supervision, overhead, equipment, hourly wages and fringe benefits of the employees involved.
